

2018 AP EXAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION



WHO

ALL AP STUDENTS

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Langham Creek High School desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes that they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit while enrolled in high school courses, saving a significant amount of money on tuition. You should examine the “AP Acceptance Policies” at the schools to which you are applying. This website will provide helpful information: www.collegeboard.org/ap/creditpolicy/.

WHEN

- **May 7th – May 18th**
- Morning exams begin promptly at **8:00 a.m. Arrive at 7:20 a.m. to hear exam instructions and be seated.**
- Afternoon exams begin promptly at **12:00 p.m. Arrive at 11:30 a.m. to hear exam instructions and be seated.**
- **If you arrive after the exam has started, you will not be allowed to enter and will not receive a refund. Afternoon testing may go beyond school hours. Please make arrangements accordingly.**

WHERE

Langham Creek High School – Exact room locations will be posted in mid-April.

HOW MUCH

- **\$98 per exam if paid during regular registration**
- **\$108 per exam if paid during late registration**
- **\$33 per exam - Free and Reduced Program (A confirmation email will be sent if approved in order to continue registration.)**
- **\$43 per exam if paid during late registration - Free and Reduced Program (A confirmation email will be sent if approved in order to continue registration.)**

PAYMENT

Payments will be made either by **credit/debit card online** or print off the invoice and mail with a cashier’s check to Total Registration (Please write your reference number in the memo area of the check). Please have your credit/debit card with you before beginning the registration process. **Unpaid registration will be canceled and exams will not be ordered. Fees will be applied to canceled or no show exams.**

REGISTRATION

- Go to www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/443424
- Complete Demographic Information for you and your parent. **Include an active email address as we will be sending important notifications through email.**
- Select exam and **teacher** for each exam (see chart on the back)
 - Note: Select **Independent Study** if you are re-taking an AP exam or if you are taking an exam for a class you are currently not enrolled in at this time
- Print Confirmation Page for your records. **You are not registered until you arrive at the confirmation page.**
- **REGISTRATION** – January 8th (12:01 a.m.) – March 2nd (11:59 p.m.)
- **LATE REGISTRATION** – March 3rd (12:01 a.m.) – March 9th (11:59 p.m.) (**\$10 late fee charged per exam during this time period**)

SCHOLARSHIPS

An application and essay is required describing extenuating circumstances supporting a need for financial assistance. AP Cy Hope Scholarship Applications and additional information may be picked up at Counselor’s Corner during all lunches. **Applications will be evaluated on a first come, first serve basis. Submit applications ASAP to the Counselors’ Secretary, Mrs. Bishop, in the Counseling Office.**

OTHER INFORMATION

We strongly recommend that parents and students are present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered. Students may receive a full refund if an exam is canceled by March 2nd (11:59 p.m.) or a partial refund (\$35 cancellation fee) if canceled between March 4th (12:01 a.m.) – March 9th (11:59 a.m.) **No refunds will be honored after March 9th (11:59 a.m).**
